

How to Arrange Fresh Flowers

Have fun arranging flowers from your garden or local market, says Josh Tierney, of Great Performances. Aim to please yourself, and your floral pieces will be fabulous.

Creative Containers

When you're choosing a container for your floral arrangement, look around your home, says Tierney. He suggests a set of eclectic teacups, "an old,

brass Moroccan urn, a silver English teapot or a china compote." Look for containers in thrift stores, flea markets and yard sales, or check around your home for pails, old vases or vintage buckets. The front container shown here holds anemones. The one on the left is filled with succulents; the one on the right holds stems of veronica.
