“Katchkie Farm started out as a 60-acre field that had never been plowed before. Now we’ve got three 3,000-square-foot greenhouses and about 40 acres of cultivated land where we grow everything from microgreens to colored carrots without dumping any chemicals into the ground. We do it that way because it’s better for the earth. Do organic tomatoes taste better? I don’t know. But fresh tastes better, which is the whole idea behind the ‘farm to table’ movement. We sell Katchkie products at farmers’ markets and through Great Performances - and we bring kids to our Sylvia Center to show them where real food comes from. They go home liking broccoli, and their mothers faint.”
